I am quite proud of them also, as I have seen many become quite seasoned readers and thinkers, with their enthusiasm growing as the more competitive class becomes. Of course, competition does not constitute the whole ethos of our class, since these are children and so we have fun also, shown in the songs we learn and the stories I often read to them, as well as the jokes we share in class.

January will see us continue with the weekly introduction of words that will be repeated until ingrained in the children's minds; most of all this is achieved through our reading session, and with such books as *When I Get Bigger*, *I Just Forget*, and *Me Too*, there will be a wealth of English to learn. This also can be quite subjective, as opposed to the more objective core material books, because when we read the books I often question the students about their own lives: this was shown, for example, in December as we read *What a Bad Dream*, when I questioned students on the dreams they have had and differentiated between dreams and nightmares. Of course, there was a strong emphasis on dreams being not real! And this goes for the books we will read in January, they introduce the real world and concepts of responsibility, as well as the vocabulary that exists amongst these concepts.

So, we Pandas are marching into the New Year with something of triumph and a burgeoning élan, having seen a glorious 2015 behind us! Bravo, Pandas! Bravo!

Reading January will be an important month for our students, continuing with the critter series which will embody important information on life's changes such as in *When I Get Bigger*.

Furthermore, this will be a month of review also as the students prepare for the reading competition which will see them go over old books to see just how successfully they have mastered reading them.

Core Material In core material we will revise the words learnt from our readings about plants, growing and changes; these words I will also encourage to be used in other contexts. Also, we will delve further on into the book at times, as we have already done, learning about folktales and fables (as in the story of the *The Gingerbread Man*); this will then introduce a wealth of independent material I can add to class, such as fables we grew up knowing in Britain.

Maths The maths books this month will be much more sum-based, subtly dropping the contexts which were hitherto used, such as the animals students had to count or the colours they had to use: some of the activities are near enough to being just plains arithmetic sums, which moreover become more difficult the further one gets in the books (meaning larger numbers are used). This is all a positive and gradual honing of mathematical skills.
