Dear Parents,

I have been with the Dragons for two months now and am continually amazed at what a great group I have. Their personalities are becoming stronger as they become more and more used to me and how I am as a teacher. We have had a few tears in the mornings but this has become less and less which is great to see. I try to make them feel relaxed around me and let them know that I am their 'School Father'.

April will see us continue with the weekly introduction of words but I am now trying to put these words into sentence and develop their understanding of how this fits into their daily lives. For example 'he is big' or 'she is little' or ask questions such as 'why can't we have outdoor play today?' with the answer being 'it is raining or it is wet.

I am trying to encourage them to 'speak English' rather than say 'no Chinese'. This is a positive reinforcement technique where they associate English as a good thing.

We will continue to develop our Dragons into boys and girls with good manners who help and look after their classmates. It is nice to see classmates saying 'don't cry' and giving their classmates a hug if they are upset.

We will have some new songs to learn this month which are fun and educational. As usually there will be new words and actions to learn to get the children moving and shake off the morning sleepiness!!


