

FROG CLASS August / September Newsletter

Hello! And welcome back to the new semester. Frog Class are now K5 and in their final year. It's hard to believe the students have been at this school from K3 to K4 and now K5.

It's been a real privilege to witness their progress. When they first arrived at the school, communication was almost impossible. They couldn't speak a word of English. Now it's amazing to hear them chatting away to one another and reading by themselves.

Now they have reached K5 the workload will become more intense. Now they have a great English foundation to build on. The focus will be on really pushing them to read and write, to understand spelling rules, articulate speech, and use grammar correctly.

So let's take a look at what is to come in the coming months.

Reading

We read the reading books several times every day. I am very strict when it comes to reading time. Everyone sits down on the floor and we read together following the words with our fingers.

Often the kids will have questions about the story and about words they don't understand. I positively encourage questions about the reading material and make sure they understand.

After reading together, individuals are chosen to read to the whole class so their pronunciation can be checked and corrected if necessary. Sometimes during outdoor play I will give extra reading practice and attention to those who need it.

August

Week 1 - Green, Green Garden - Little Critter and his family plant some vegetables. After lots of watering, weeding, and waiting, they enjoy a delicious meal—all from their green, green garden. Week 2 - Just Critters Who Care - When Little Critter finds out one of his neighbours is in need, he and his friends rally together and volunteer their help. They soon learn community service is rewarding . . . and fun! Who can the Critters help next?

Week 3 - Just Saving My Money - When Little Critter wants a new skateboard, Dad tells him that he needs to save his own money to buy it! From feeding the dog to selling lemonade, Little Critter learns the value of a dollar.

Week 4 - Just Helping My Dad - Little Critter is going to help his dad all day long! Things might not always go as planned, but that doesn't stop Little Critter from trying his hardest!

September

Week 1 - Snowball Soup - What does a snowman like to eat? Snowball soup, of course! Join Little Critter, Little Sister, and Dog as they make their new friend a tasty treat.

Week 2 - This is My Town - Little Critter shares what he knows about his neighbours and the places to go in Critterville. Who delivers the mail? Where does Little Critter go to see a movie? Who keeps everyone safe? Come explore the town with Little Critter and discover where everyone works and plays!

Week 3 - Review

Week 4 - Going to the Firehouse - Whoosh! goes the water hose. Ooo! Eee! Ooo! goes the siren. Ding! Ding! goes the fire alarm. Little Critter and his classmates are taking a trip to the firehouse! Little Critter puts on his boots and jacket—now he's ready to help Fireman Joe. After checking the hose and ladder, Little Critter is ready for a fireman's helmet of his own. Join Little Critter as he learns to stop, drop, and roll with Fireman Joe!

Week 5 - Going to the Sea Park - Little Critter and his classmates go on a trip to the Sea Park! Join them on their saltwater adventure as they learn about sea creatures big and small.

Core Material

The Core Material books this semester are very good with nice pictures and many useful words. There are three books, a reading/writing Workshop workbook, a writing workbook and a Literature Anthology reading book.

Reading

我們每一天閱讀讀本許多次,當涉及到閱讀時,我是很嚴格的。每個人坐在地板上且我們跟 隨我們的手指一起閱讀。

往往孩子們會有一些故事或是他們不懂的語詞問題,我會積極鼓勵他們發問,以確保他們了解內容。

經過一起閱讀後,選擇一個人閱讀給全班聽,可以檢查他們的發音在必要時修正。有時在戶 外遊戲時,我會進行額外的閱讀練習。我會留意哪些人是需要的。

八月
