Dear Parents,

This past month has been very fun and eventful. All of the students made significant amounts of progress and, I believe, learned a great deal. We also focused a lot on fun, with plenty of songs and dancing, play time, and new games. I think the students all made lots of new friends and they all seem to be getting along very nicely. We learned many new things and introduced some new concepts such as tracing and recognizing phonetic sounds. We also focused a great deal on reinforcing the classroom rules and rewarding positive behavior.

We have focused a lot on teaching them to play nicely and being thoughtful of other students, sit nicely during class time, not run around in the classroom and practice basic manners such as saying please and thank you. The students all have a much better grasp on the classroom routines, but I continue to work to remind them not to shout or play in the bathroom or hallways while changing their shoes. We also worked a lot on basic conversational skills and almost all the students are usually able to have basic conversations with me if I ask how they are or what things they like. And all of them seem to enjoy song time and singing along with me. I am very proud of their progress so far.

This next month is going to be very fun and educational. We will be introducing a lot of new material, as well reviewing and continuing to reinforce the things they have already learned. We will also start to place a greater emphasis on fundamentals and fine motor skills. The basic skills we will be focusing on include tracing and letter recognition. I think tracing is of vital importance as they start to learn to draw basic shapes and simple letters. I have been spending a lot of one-on-one time working with them on developing these skills, and I will continue to focus on it a lot in the coming months.

Reading Class

Last month was very important for reading class as we introduced borrowing books from the library. I hope this will help to spark their interest in reading, many of the students already seem very enthusiastic about reading new books and I am very happy to see that. This month we will continue to try to encourage their interest in reading by going to the library and having recreational reading time in class or during breaks. This months reading books are very educational and great for teaching new

sentence patterns. For instances, "Hats" teaches 'I like' sentences and "I can, we can" teaches a lot of great action words. I am really looking forward to this month and helping them learn and grow. Listed below is the curriculum schedule for this month of classes.

The students learned a lot of new letters and sounds last month so we will continue to review again and again throughout the next month. I think it is very important that all the students have a good understanding of the letters we've already learned before moving on to higher levels as these fundamentals are vital to their education. We will focus a lot on pronouncing and recognizing phonetic sounds, as well letters. We will start, more and more, associating words with certain sounds and letters. We will start to focus a lot more on tracing but I expect their progress will be slow as they are still working to develop their writing skills and I will be very patient and work one-on-one with them quite a bit. We will also be learning the "Can I?" question sentence pattern which I will be very useful for the students in class as they start to ask more questions and make more conversation.
