Dear Parents,

I'd like to begin by thanking you all so much for your help and participation during both the Halloween activity and the Drama Play. We really enjoyed the opportunity to have so many fun and educational activities with the students and I think it meant so much to them and they really enjoyed themselves. We have a lot of fun activities coming up this month as well, such as our Christmas celebration and performances. I think the students will really enjoy this a lot, as it is a great opportunity to explore other countries' cultures and traditions, as well as explore a fun new holiday.

This last month the students made so much progress with their English studies, as we finished our first run through of the Alphabet and began introducing more advanced English phrases. The students are learning at an amazing rate, and I am so impressed with their dedication and enthusiasm for learning. I tried my best to make are classes fun and engaging and give the students a lot to look forward to each day and I think they are responding really well to this style of teaching and they have so much to show for it. They have begun using more advanced English to make conversation and they are constantly pointing out and saying English letters and numbers when they see them. They seem to particularly enjoy reading and singing. They also all put in so much hard work and dedication into practicing for the drama play and, although it's still there first drama play so they might be a bit nervous or forget some of their lines, I am still so proud of their effort. I can tell they are all trying their best.

This next month we will focus much more on phonics and reading. The students have made so much progress with the Alphabet and I think they should be ready fairly soon to start working on some basic short vowels and phonetic combinations. I have also created some comprehensive sets of flash cards to accompany our Core Material books. I think this will especially help them to remember the vocabulary and learn valuable new sentences. I have high hopes for their progress this month and I am so excited to continue to watch them grow.

## **Reading Class**

Last month we had very little time actually dedicated to reading assignments as we were mostly focused on the drama play. But this month we will return to our previous schedule of one reading book per week. The first book we'll be reading, titled "Is It Time?" is going to be a great introduction to talking about time words. We will incorporate this a lot into our classroom Enligh and hopefully they will add it to their daily vocabulary as well. The next title is "Apples", which focuses on counting and numbers. I think the children will especially enjoy this, as it will give them an oppurtunity to demonstrate all of the number skills they have learned in math class. "Noisy Breakfast" also introduces a lot of fun sound words and "Where Do Insects Live?" will give us a chance to dicususs some great new topics. ### **Phonics Class**

Our phonics class this month will be very important, so I also want to continue to steadily review as well, so as not to overwhelm them with too much information. Depending on how well they continue to perform in phonics, I may even begin to introduce short vowels and basic phonics blends. I think this is so vital to the students' development as they begin to learn to read more and words. I think that this increased focus on phonics, combined with our sight reading practice, will help the students make so much progress this coming month. #### **Core Material Class**

I am very excited for this month's core material class, as I have just recently prepared a comphrehensive set of flashcards to accompy each unit as we make our way through the core material books. As I have stated before, core material class is a great oppurtunity for the students to learn new vocabulary words and brand new sentence patterns. In Unit 3, we will learn a lot of new fun action words, such as pat, tap and sip. The students will also learn new ways to use 'sence' words like "hear, see and touch". And Unit 4 will teach them fun new words about firefighters and we will take it as an oppurtunity to discuss other professions as well. #### Math Class

Last month we focused mostly on our drama play and didn't have much time for math class but this month we will be giving it our full attention. Our Math classes for this month are fairly straight forward and I think all of the materials we will be covering is very important practice for them learning counting and how to work with numbers. We will be doing a lot of counting items in a group and matching the number of items to the correct

number. We will also start to work on tracing the numbers, as well as playing some fun counting games on the board. Listed below is the curriculum schedule for this month of classes. December
