#### Grammar

#### Composition

Composition Class is a fantastic opportunity for the students to do some creative writing. It's quite a short class, just once per week but it gives them a chance to think for themselves and write creatively.

A topic is chosen for them such as 'What I Want to Do When I Grow Up', after which we have a discussion and suggestions are made as to what they might write. After the initial draft is finished, their compositions are marked and returned ready for the rewrite the following week.

June-

We will spend a few weeks writing about 'Food'- food we like or dislike, why we like or dislike and comparing different types of food. We will discuss and compare the reasons why we have these feelings.

## **Keynote Presentations**

This semester we are trying something a little different to last semester. We are only doing three topics so the students can spend more time researching the topics to find lots of relevant and interesting information. The three topics will be spread out of the four months so at the moment we are looking at 'Developing Countries'. The students have previously studied more well known countries such as England, Canada or the USA so this will give them the opportunity to learn lots of new vocabulary, places, and about new cultures.
