

Dear Shark Class parents,

This month we will use the handwriting book more regularly. We will also start to use the phonics book as a source of extra vocabulary. They should be able to pick up some of the most common nouns, in addition to hearing the words spoken. We will concentrate on the consonants because there is a lot more variety in vowels, and consonants are easier to remember.

I am reading Dr. Seuss books to them as a class. They are very fond of the book "Green Eggs and Ham" and I will get them reading "Hop on Pop" one by one with me at the front of the class.

We continue to play alphabet games, and more of the students can identify all the letters now. There are six who need extra help.

The math course, MPM is hard for them, so we do that work in small groups.

We will have practices to do for the drama. I have tried to use patterns from class in the drama wherever possible, so the practice can reinforce what we have learned in class.

I am trying to keep things light, so they can keep their enthusiasm. I don't want them to feel overwhelmed by a task that is hard for them at four or five years but will be easy when they are six or seven. I am letting them set the pace, and I am adapting the material to fit what they are happy to do.
