Dear Shark Class parents,

The drama practice eats up quite a bit of time, but the class is starting to know some of the lines. Each part is played by three children, so they can reinforce each other, and so the shy children do not feel the pressure of a speaking role.

This month is for the choreography and staging. Again this is done in threes, because working together is easier.

Progress is slow, but steady. Discipline is good and the class is motivated and happy pretty much all the time.

I am reading Dr. Seuss books to them as a class. They are very fond of the book "Green Eggs and Ham" .

The math course, MPM is hard for them, so we do that work in small groups.

We will have practices to do for the drama. I have tried to use patterns from class in the drama wherever possible, so the practice can reinforce what we have learned in class.

I am trying to keep things light, so they can keep their enthusiasm. I don't want them to feel overwhelmed by a task that is hard for them at four or five years but will be easy when they are six or seven. I am letting them set the pace, and I am adapting the material to fit what they are happy to do.

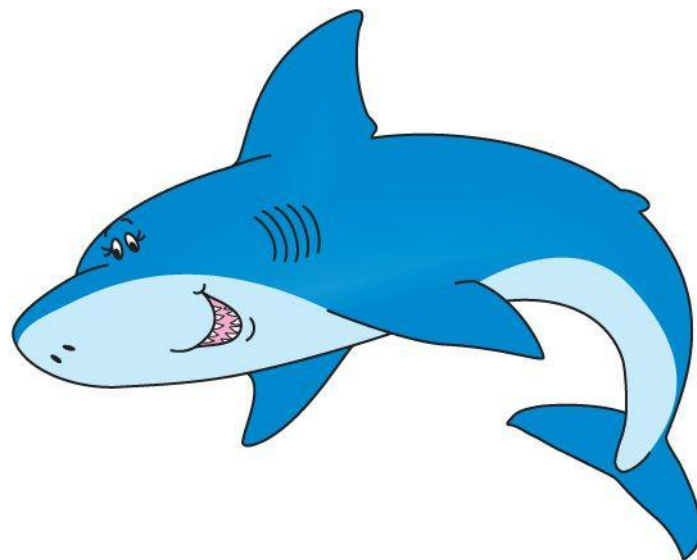
