This month the students have a lot going on. As we have completed our entire sections on short and long vowels, the students are ready to get much more serious about spelling and writing different words. They are familiar with a large variety of words and sentence structures already and I am working with them to refine their knowledge and be able to write more and more difficult sentences. I am very proud of the progress they are making and I think it will be more than enough to prepare them for starting K5 next year.

We will also continue to focus on their other important skills, including reading, comprehension, math and grammar. The students have also been using their new writing work book a lot. This book has been teaching them important grammatical concepts such as nouns and verbs. So far they have all had no problem understanding it and are actually able to list off lots of different verbs and nouns all on their own. In the future they will be learning more difficult concepts like prepositions and adjectives. I'm sure they will be able to grasp that fully and quickly as well.

# **Reading Class**

The students have been doing very well in their reading class. Lately, I have been very impressed at how quickly they are able to memorize the new books and learn the new words. I think this is, in part, due to how many reading words they've learned already and how much their phonics has improved.
