

# Shark Class Newsletter September 2019

The students are all settled in comfortably to their new surroundings and the new schedule. The workload seems lighter for the fact they don't have to catch up on material, which has allowed for extra time to practice what they already know. Grammar points are the foundation of speaking English well and these points are emphasized with every exercise and activity using new vocabulary every time. The more vocabulary that is learned, the more effective the students can communicate, and the greater the understanding of grammar the more accurate they can do it.

#### Reading

Reading books follow the K4 collections, and simple in comparison as they are to the K5 collection, they still provide a necessary step into new vocabulary and its usage.

Week 1 - "Joshua James Likes Trucks"

Week 2 - "It's Circle Time! Shapes"

Week 3 - "Here Comes the Parade"

Week 4 - "I Love Trees"

#### Core Material

We have completed the first unit in the wonders series and will have begun the second unit before starting the new month. The students all managed the unit easily enough and even though it was an easy section and they are very familiar with the use of short 'a' it was good practice for them and hopefully they will have committed the material to long term memory now. We will also be touching on the third unit before September ends having covered even more of the short vowel sounds.

#### **Phonics**

The short vowel sounds are mostly covered in the core material and the Phonics book continues to cover all other short vowel sounds. There is also a short few collections of letter blend sounds, on top of which I am trying to emphasize the sounds of 'th' and 'sh' and 'er' as these frequently come up in the new vocabulary we are learning. Further and in between we will do various exercises of word families.

## Workbook Jump 2

The Jump 2 workbook, logically, follows the same methods as in the first book, and I believe the students are quite familiar with how it works. So hopefully we will be able to continue as usual throughout this book revising all the topics shared in the Phonics and Writing books.

#### Writing

"Write Now!" from Tim Budden is the book we use for the writing subject and the conversation classes. As I mentioned before the book looks fairly intimidating and the students all felt overwhelmed to start, however while we work through it little bit by little bit, the students are realising that if they listen intently then they are able to follow just fine. However the students who still feel its too hard are realising that when they don't listen or get distracted then they will get completely lost.

## MPM Math (Multiple Practice Module)

The MPM Math series focuses a lot on a variety of daily problem solving strategies, not just math, although counting plays a large role in the functions of the guided stories through a variety of topics, including farming, travel, colour coordination, baked goods, sweets, exploring and many more. These also provide great material for conversation practice, including but not limited to: what fruit and vegetables do you like, I like.... and have you ever picked or planted.... and have you ever taken a plane or been on a bus or or .....

#### Library

While all the kids have enjoyed sitting and watching teacher read stories out during library time, I have decided to have constructive individual reading sessions. So we will try to alternate weeks where students choose their own books in pairs or more and read to each other, then back to listen to teacher share a story. I am not sure if they are ready for this from a disciplined perspective, as some students may prefer to play than to read constructively. As with all updates, I will keep you all informed with how this pans out. Thus far we have moved Library time into the classroom to accommodate all the late arriving students and I bring up a book to read to them.

# Spelling

As I mentioned in the introduction to the newsletter, there will be a spelling test on the weeks 10 words every Friday. The results of which will be monitored and shared for progress reporting, but I also expressed that this is not to be taken with heavy heart if met with failure or absence. It is only for progress monitoring and added incentive or motivation to retain what's being learnt. Some

kids have taken to testing quite well and others are struggling to retain the knowledge. If parents could kindly help their kids with the words of the week, by just repeating the word and spelling it out loud letter by letter, each word simply once everyday will make a huge difference.

This months spelling vocabulary are:


