## **Reading Class**

We will continue our starter books from the starting set that the school gets from scholastic. It is very important that these books relate to the other work we are doing in our phonics and core materials classes. Competent readers need to understand the link between phonics and reading.

Week 1- Kittens

Week 2- We are Painting

Week 3- Big and Small

Week 4- I like Shapes

### Core Materials

We already have looked into our start smart core materials books a little bit because they do focus on the alphabet a lot in the beginning and try to show the kids the link between the words and phonics in the beginning.

Week 1- Start Smart: We are Special Week 2- Start Smart: My Family and Me

Week 3- Start Smart: I Can!

Week 4- Start Smart: What Can I Do?

## **Phonics Class**

Phonics class has been going very well in our class, because of the earlier understanding of the alphabet in a lot of the students in our class. This understanding, and that not everyone knows

everything will help the class learn from each other. Sometimes the best way to learn is to teach your friend!

Week 1- P23-26: Initial and Final Consonant – I, d, c, n, g, w

Week 2- P27-30: Connecting Sound to Symbol – r, k

Week 3- P31-34: Connecting Sound to Symbol – j, k, v

Week 4- P35-38: Initial and Final Consonant – p, r, k, j, q

#### Work Book

Our work book will continue to practice writing nouns and reinforcing useful sentence patterns. By the end of the month we will start to look at verbs, which we will have talked about in core materials.

#### Conversation

Our conversation class is where we will also be practicing vocab, adjectives and questions. I will start our conversation classes with a 10-15 minute practice for whatever subject we will be practicing followed by the written work in the book. If they don't finish their written work in the time given then I will find another time in the day for them to finish it.

Week 1: P14, 15 - What is it? It's a fish.

Week 2: P 16, 17 - Review Week 3: P18, 19 - Numbers

Week4: P20, 21 – It's a bird. They're birds.

### Math Class

In our math book we will complete our unit on numbers 1 to 6 in our first book of the C series, and move onto our next book that will take us to a candy store in our sticker books. After the Candy store we will be quickly counting from 1-10 for the first week, then doing comparative adjectives for the rest of that book.

Week 1: P9-10: Set Theory

Week 2: P11-12: Reciting Numbers Week 3: P13-14: Measurements Week 4: P15-16: Counting Objects

## P.E. Class

In our P.E. class we will be doing some simple games that will use common verbs to help kids understand directions. This will be anything from Simon Says to The Zoo Races. We will be sharing our P.E. class time with Monkey class, so sometimes we will do activities together and sometimes we will do them apart but we will always try to have fun together outside.

## **Outdoor Playtime**

During outdoor playtime we will allow the kids to release some energy in our supervised and controlled playground outside. We will be sharing the playground with Lion class, Monkey class, and Dinosaur class. There are always lots of teachers outside and camera's so that we can review any incidents that may occur

The first month has been really good so far and I have seen all kinds of progress throughout the whole class. Everyone is a lot happier in the class at this time and adjusting very well to the atmosphere.

I hope that all the kids have been saying good things at home and I am always grateful to hear what happens on the weekend with all the students in my classes so don't be shy about writing in the communication books on the weekends.

## 發音課程

## 練習本(Work Book)課程

## MPM 課程

在 MPM 的課程中,我們將完成 C 系列的第一本書,在第一本書我們學習到認識數字 1 到 6 和數與量的概念,接下會進行第二本書的學習,另外我們會運用到貼紙書,從糖果商店學習數和量的概念。 在糖果店之後,我們將在第一周進行 1-10 數序,其它進度内容將包括大小、長短的 Week 1: P9-10:

Week 2: P11-12: Reciting Numbers Week 3: P13-14: Measurements Week 4: P15-16: Counting Objects

### 體能課程

我們將設計一些簡單的小活動,我會試著利用一些常用動詞來協助孩子理解。有時候我們會和猴子班的小朋友一些進行 P.E.課程,增加趣味和多變性,有時我們會把二班分開,進行不同的活動,無論如何孩子們可以在戶外享受大肢體的伸展和認識更多的朋友。

## 戶外遊戲時間

在戶外遊戲時間,我們將讓孩子們盡情釋放能量,在我們的陪伴和照顧,我們將與獅子班、猴子班和恐龍班共用操場。老師們會注意孩子們的安全,以避免意外事件發生。
