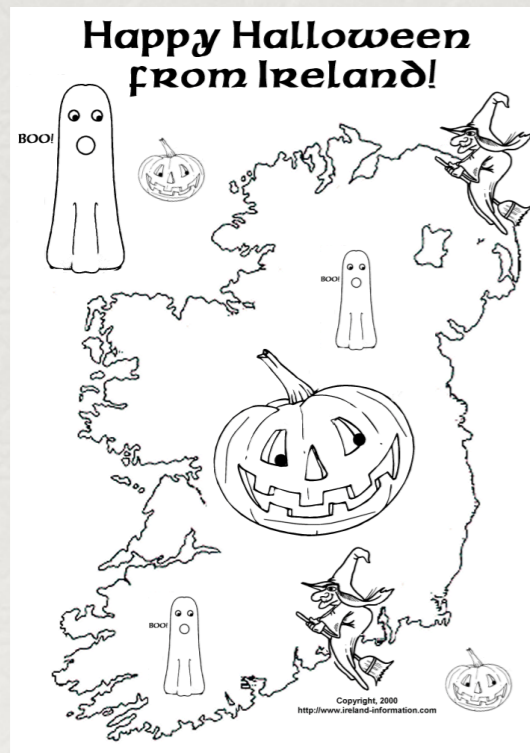
Who usually celebrates Halloween?

Halloween is usually celebrated by both adults and kids. Some families celebrate by having costume parties and playing special games like bobbing for Apples and telling ghost stories.

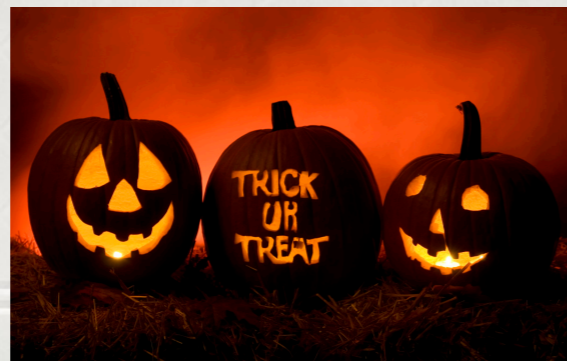


Where do people usually celebrate Halloween?
