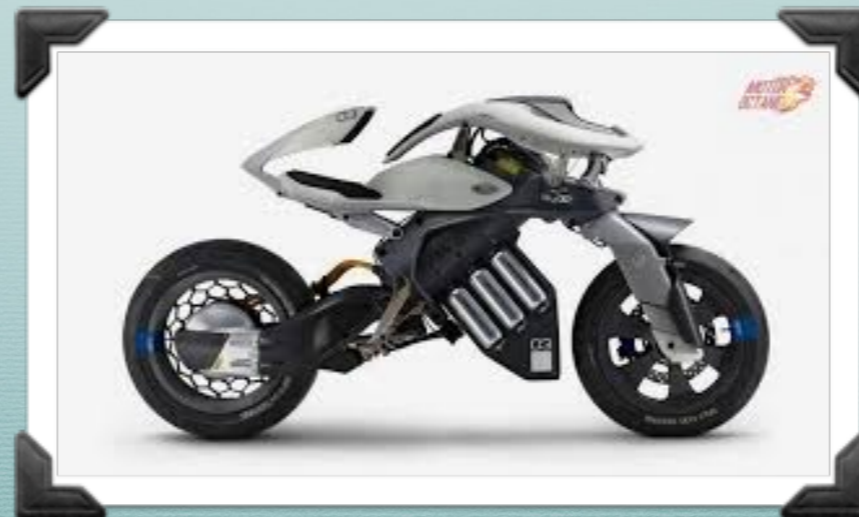




Planes, trains, buses, cars, motorcycles and bicycles are all different types of transportation. We all use at least one type of transportation to get around.

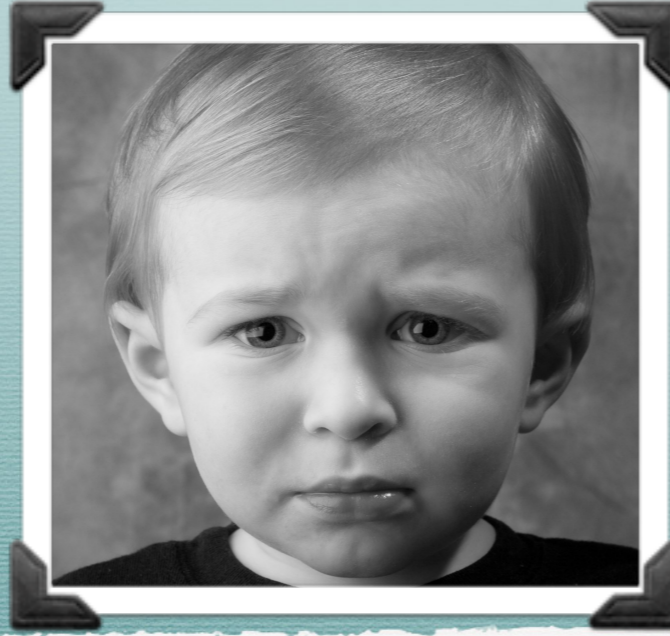
