MPM will keep up the push on counting, assembling, and addition exercises. In addition, the writing portion will remain the most challenging for them. It is my hope that the Deer students will be able to think creatively and independently.

The large project of importance in November will be the drama practice or play. It will be an interesting story based on how people/characters should treat each other; being treated nicely. The queen is having her birthday party celebration and all the princesses are invited as is the local dragon. There is some unhappiness about the local dragon being invited because some princesses think he 'looks' scary. We really should not judge based on how someone looks on the outside.
