### Dear Parents,

Deer is staying right on the line for the monthly targets. It does take time to master a new language and that's why each course is important in its own way. The push in December will be the Christmas theme: reindeer, Santa Claus, gifts, snowflakes, candy canes, and Christmas trees, too. Our Deer class will keep pushing ahead with all subjects in our schedule. They will enjoy the Christmas songs given. They do very well on learning the lyrics fast and the tempo of songs, too. Each of the reading stories are adored by the Deer students. The students are able to fully comprehend each story by late week. In December, I will be taking the lead in the thematic classes. The theme is about Christmas. One week will be a wreath made from the students' hand outlines, another week will be a cooking class with sweets, a Christmas tree, a Santa face, and a winter craft, too. I hope all of it works out for the students to enjoy the holiday spirit. In both the phonics and grammar, the emphasis is on various drills: fill-in-the-blanks, vowels, sentence order arrangement, and tenses. MPM will focus on more counting and addition drills. The goal will be to complete all of the E4 books and start the E5 series. Furthermore, writing will continue to be the most thought-provoking for the students. I do want the Deer students to be able to independently and on their own.

Decorations will be put on the classroom front windows. Hopefully the children will talk about it and parents will find the time to come and take a look and enjoy.

#### **Phonics Class**
