# The different ways people celebrate Easter?

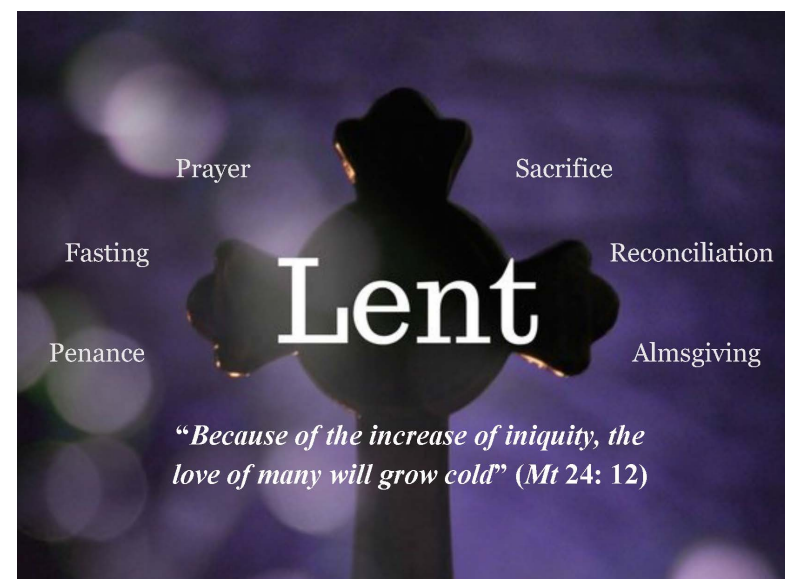
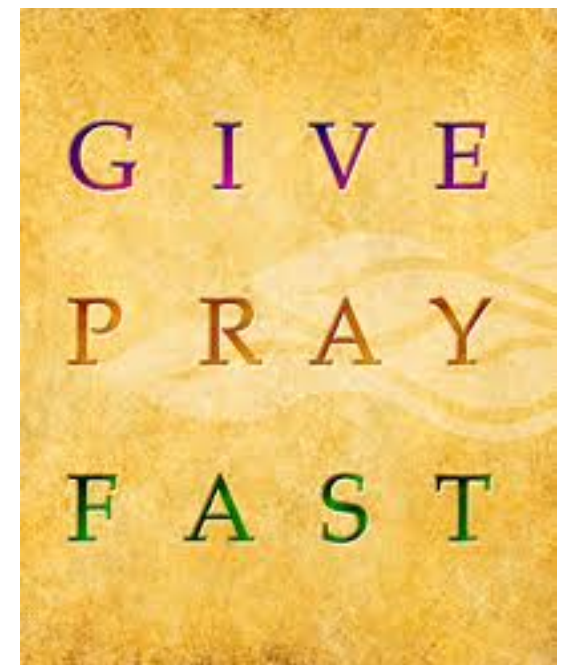
