After the reading contest, the phonics book, core material book and conversation books will be the main focus until the start of the new semester. Most of the children have progressed well in English and are quite used to using English every day, all day. I am very pleased to spend time with them and witness their personal growth on a daily basis.

Reading

Reading and reviewing these short stories is fun for young children. As your child reviews these books, they become more familiar with basic phonics and key vocabulary. As they listen to and learn to recite these interesting stories, which are read in a fun and animated way, they build a desire to participate and learn to read rather quickly. Phonics
