

Whale Class Newsletter September 2020

Hello Parents,

We are now a month into K5 and I think the class are doing well. Everyone seems to have adapted to the new material, and the class are doing a good job at keeping up with the busy schedule and the new writing books. There are no special events planned this month.

Core Material

For core material we are starting chapter 2 of the workshop book, "Buildings All Around". The story is called "Cubs in a Hut" and we will also discuss different kinds of buildings in the city. The phonics is short U and the key words are "could", "live", "one", "then" and "three". In the final week we will switch to the anthology book and read the story "The Pigs, The Wolf and the Mud."

- Week 1: Phonics and key words
- Week 2: Reading and Q&A
- Week 3: Reading and Q&A + free talk
- Week 4: Anthology The Pigs, The Wolf and the Mud

Conversation/Grammar (Jump Book)

The Jump Book is used for conversation and grammar. So we will do the tasks in the workbook and also use it for vocabulary and sentence patterns. The first month is fairly easy and reviews concepts from the last book, so the class will be able to review what they have learned before we move onto new things.

Week 1: Have/has + spelling Week 2: Food and Drink (like/don't like) Week 3: He eats/he doesn't eat Week 4: Review week

Phonics

Phonics is very similar to last semester's work. We are using the same series of books, so the kids are familiar with the exercises we will be doing. The first month seems to be a warm up, with lots of practice of short vowels. This will be a good opportunity for the class to review and catch up if needed. I expect we will have lots of extra time so we will also use some of this time for spelling. Week 1: Sentence writing + comprehension

Week 2: Short Vowels (review)

Week 3: Long a (a i+ ay)

Week 4: Review week

Writing

We have a new book called "Write Now" for the K5 classes. This book is challenging as it requires the students to write long sentences and do things like write a letter to a friend. It will take a will for many students to adjust to the large amount of writing required and the very small spaces available on the page.

Week 1: Singular & plural nouns Week 2: Food Week 3: Unit Review - nouns Week 4: Review week

Story Books

During reading class, I will have a lot of Q & A time to help the kids understand the story. Week 1: The Three Little Kittens Get Dressed Week 2: Ready Freddy Week 3: The Ants Go Marching Week 4: Review week

Math

This month we start with some fairly easy concepts. In week 1 we will be counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers. Then identifying missing numbers. We then move onto more than/less than and will do the sticker book in the final week.

Week 1: Book 2 – Co-ordinates

Week 2: Book 2 - ordinal numbers (first, second) and counting

Week 3: Book 2 – Spatial awareness and counting

Week 4: Review week

Physical Education

I plan and implement activities for the classes each week. The students have a good mix of different games to play during PE classes, the students will have lots of fun. For PE I like to give the students obstacle courses and relay races and other activities that are fairly easy to understand.

Week 1: Grab the baton Week 2:Obstacle Course Week 3: Tricycle Race Week 4: Obstacle Course


Thematic Activity September's thematic will be about the Moon Festival.

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親愛的家長您好,

現在我們已經進入K5了一個月,我認為大家都表現得很好。每個人似乎都已經適應了新的教材,並且 班級在繁忙的日程中的表現和新的寫作書方面做得很好。本月沒有計劃舉辦任何特別活動。

Core Material主教材:

對於主教材,我們將從workshop的第二章"全方位建築"開始。 這個故事稱為"小屋裡的小熊",我們還將 討論城市中各種建築物。 發音的語音是短U, 關鍵詞是"可以", "活著", "一個", "然後"和"三個"。 在 最後一周,我們將轉換到anthology book, 並閱讀故事"豬, 狼和泥漿"。

Conversation/Grammar (Jump Book) 對話/文法

Jump Book用於會話和語法。因此,我們將在工作簿中執行任務,並將其用於詞彙和句子模式。第一個 月很容易,並且可以回顧上一本書中的概念,因此,在我們學習新事物之前,課程將能夠回顧他們學到 的知識。

第一週: Have/has 有+拼音

第二週:食物及飲料(喜歡/不喜歡)

第三週: 他吃/他不吃

第四週: 複習週

Phonics發音

拼音與上學期的作品非常相似。 我們使用的是同一系列的書,所以孩子們會熟悉我們將要做的練習。 第一個月似乎是一個熱身,練習了很多短母音。 如果需要,這將是全班同學進行複習和加強印象的好 機會。 我希望我們會有很多額外的時間,因此我們還將運用這段時間來練習一些拼寫。

- 第一週: 句子書寫+理解
- 第二週: 短母音(複習)
- 第三週: 長母音a (ai + ay)
- 第四週: 複習週
- Writing寫作

對於K5的班級,我們有一本名為"Write Now"的新書。這本書對小孩是有挑戰性的,因為它要求學生寫 長句子並做諸如寫信給朋友的事情。許多學生將需要適應大量的寫作要求和頁面上很小的空間。

- 在閱讀課上,我們進行了大量問答讓小孩回答,這樣有助他們對故事的理解。

- 第三週: 螞蟻行軍
- 第四週: 複習週
- Math數學邏輯

這個月,我們從一些相當簡單的概念開始。在第一周,我們將向前和向後計數並寫數字。然後識別丢 失的號碼。然後,我們轉換了解大於/小於,並在最後一周進行貼紙集。

- Physical Education體能活動

每個禮拜我設計了一些活動可以實行,孩子們能夠將許多不一樣的遊戲搭配在一起,孩子們將會覺得很 有趣。我也喜歡提供孩子們一些障礙超越訓練遊戲的接力賽,以及其他一些簡單讓孩子們可以理解去玩 的遊戲。
