Dear Parents,

I am pleased with K5 Unicorn students' learning ability. I am honored to be their teacher and I will do my utmost to make sure each student will succeed in accomplishing their class goals for this semester. Their reading continues to be strong and fluid due to the reading and the core material classes. These lessons help tremendously. Unicorn students have an active schedule both in the classroom and outside. Inside the classroom, the students enjoy having 'hands-on' time with their MPM math toolbox and the weekly thematic activity making of both arts and crafts.

This month, Unicorn students will continue to push ahead in all of their academic subjects. These subjects being: grammar, math, phonics drills, reading, and writing. The writing section is seemingly the most challenging for them. I will keep up the effort to have them write neatly, remember punctuation, and be able to comprehend the instructions. Furthermore, I want them to be able to think creatively and independently; for example, if the exercise asks about 'family' with blanks, they can first try on their own without having to constantly ask for assistance. They will be able to do the tasks and follow through. I have total confidence in each individual Unicorn student.

Reading Class

The students are doing well in reading. Their reading and comprehension levels are impressive. We first talk about the given topic/subject of the story and what they think. I then read, followed by them reading aloud. A solid way to boost their reading level would be to read to their parents at home. This process will both support their confidence levels.
