Reading

The students did wonderful during our first month of reading class. The stories were complex and challenging, yet the students demonstrated great understanding and comprehension skills. The spelling and vocabulary quizzes were a great opportunity for them to test their skills and all the new information we had learned. We spent some time getting accustomed to the new class and schedule but now I feel we have found a more steady routine that should help the students get the most out of their class time. In the coming month we will be reading two new stories and working on the comprehension, vocabulary and spelling for all of these. I hope to introduce a new game where I will ask the students to come up with sentence for our new vocabulary words to write on the board. Phonics

The start of this semester should be fairly simple for Rabbit class. We are starting out with learning the short vowels. Some of the children have already learned the short vowels, however this is still a good review, and more in depth practice for them. Last month we focused on short 'a' and 'l', this month we will continue on with short 'o', 'u', and 'e'. In each section we have a selection of different practices on our iPad and in our phonics books. Not only will I focus on learning the different phonic sounds, but I also make sure everyone knows the meaning and how to use our spelling words.

In grade one most of Rabbit class only looked up simple information for their keynotes and their teacher gave them many different sentence outline that they only needed to fill in the blanks. Now that they are in grade two I want everyone to try and look up more information on their own and write their own sentences. This will be more challenging and they will need a lot of guidance and help, but I'm sure with encouragement and supervision they will be able to do it.

This month's keynote topic will be 'countries'. Each group will pick a country and I will give everyone an outline that will tell them what to look up for each page, what information they need, and what pictures to find.

Grammar

Dear parents,

As we continue in our grammar lessons we will continue to look at the rest of the different type of sentences. The last two are commands and exclamations. We will discover how to give a command and what situations will constitute an exclamation. With these two last sentence patterns the kids will have a basic knowledge of how and when to use the different types of sentences in their writing lessons.

Week 1 – Unit 1 week 2 Commands – Examples: Set the table. Use your napkin.

Week 2 – Unit 1 week 2 Exclamations – What a fast snowball that was! I want to make a snowman!

There are lots of options available for the students to write about such as birthdays, festivals, field trips, family days out or just a special day they experienced and gives them the opportunity to draw on their own experiences.

I like to encourage creativity and imagination to produce interesting and informative compositions. I will give them examples and ideas but really want them try to think for themselves.

發音課程

這學期的開端對於小兔班而言應該非常簡單,我們將開始學習短母音,雖有些孩子們已經學習了些短母 音,但這仍是個很好的複習,對他們而言也是更深層的練習。上個月我們著重於短"a"和"I",這個月我 們將持續著重於短 "o", "u"和 "e",我們於平板及發音練習簿上針對每個部分都有些詞彙挑選,我不僅 將會著重於學習不同的發音,同時也會確認每個孩子明瞭其意涵及如何使用我們的拼字。
