## Dear Parents,

I am delighted with the Deer students' learning fortitude and strength. My goal for each semester is to have our pupils be learning in a supportive environment. The double ideas of educational value are a continued enjoyment in learning and using material for needed daily usage, so they can speak English well.

This month, Deer students will continue to push ahead and gather further steam in reach of their academic goals.

The subjects are core material, grammar (Jump), math, phonics, reading and writing. The emphasis in writing class is on finishing their assignments, being neat as much as possible, following instructions and remembering punctuation. The writing class is a bit more demanding: descriptions of family and friends, doing interviews and writing letters, ect., make this a challenging class. In phonics, we will continue working on and emphasizing all the long vowels coupled with sentence writing. In grammar (Jump) the class will press ahead with 'have' and 'don't have.' Also, we will use 'he/she has' and 'he/she doesn't have' within sentences and linking along select new vocabulary. I have confidence that each student will do well based on both teacher/student guidance and in their individual academic initiative.

## **Reading Class**

Their reading fluidity and group participation are moving along smoothly. Their enthusiasm for reading is impressive. We first talk about something similar to the topic and get ideas of what they may feel and think. I read a line or two, followed by the students, who then read the page. Once the students have finished the story, then we will have a game or two to 'liven-up' the classroom atmosphere. Parents should help by reading with their children at home. The more exposure to the

target language and more frequency, the stronger their command will be in that language. Listed below is a line up of the books they will read for November. Also, please note that in November, a fair amount of time will be dedicated for the drama play practices.

## **Phonics Class**

The students have done well with their review of short vowels, so they are now pushing further into the area of long vowels with numerous exercises and review.
