Phonics

This months in Phonics class we will be learning long and short 'I'. We will be focusing a lot on the i_e verb pattern. I have been using a variety of games to help everyone review the meanings and phonic patterns from each sections of the book. As our workbooks also have a lot to do with knowing the meaning of the words besides the phonics patters, we also spend quite a bit of time le4arning and doing review of the meanings of our phonics spelling words.

Though we spend more time in phonics class than some of Rabbit class's other classes, it is still important for everyone to do review on their own at home. As phonics is the base of reading and writing I feel this is very important for them to be familiar with all the material we learn each month. Learning and remembering the different phonics rules, especially when it comes to vowels, can be a challenge. Even with the simple vowel_e patterns it is easy to forget to look at the back of the word for the 'e' which changed the sound and makes a big difference.

So far everyone is also doing great in keynotes. Though it is hard and tough sometimes to find all the information they need for their keynotes everyone still really enjoys doing this project every month.

自然發音課程

本月於發音課程中,我們將會學到長和短音"i",我們將大量專注於 i-e 的動詞型態上,我會運用不同種類的遊戲去協助每位孩子複習練習本上每部份的單字意涵及發音形式,除了發音型態外,由於我們教課書上也有許多關於字義上的認知,故我們也會花點時間於去學習及做發音拼音字上的字義複習。

雖然我們小兔班於發音課花費的時間較其他課堂長,但對於孩子而言回家複習依然非常重要的。因為自然發音是閱讀和寫作的基礎,所以我認為讓孩子們熟悉我們每個月所學的教材十分重要。學習及記憶不同的發音規則,特別是提及母音時,那將會是個挑戰呀!甚至只是簡單的母音_e 的形式,依然很容易讓人忘記去檢視後頭的"e",這將改變整個字的讀音而且很不一樣。
