#### Hello Parents,

It's December, so the special event will be the Christmas celebration around the end of the month. It's always a fun event for the kids ans Santa will be there to give out presents. There will also be Christmas craft activities for our thematic classes.

#### Core Material

This month we will read the anthology book. There is a story and also a non-fiction story called "Kids can Help", which is about recycling. In the fourth week we will change back to the workshop book. The chapter is called "Lets Help" and contains a story about a rabbit who helps others. For phonics we will cover "th", "sh" and "-ng". The key words are "all", "call", "day", "her" and "want".

#### Conversation/Grammar (Jump Book)

The Jump Book is used for conversation and grammar. So we will do the tasks in the workbook and also use it for vocabulary and sentence patterns. The first week's work happens to be the same subject as the Write Now book, which is useful as we can spend more time on some useful sentence patterns and vocabulary. After that we move onto grammar and a review of previous lessons.

#### **Phonics**

Phonics is very similar to last semester's work. We are using the same series of books, so the kids are familiar with the exercises we will be doing. The month we will cover a range of different concepts. We have already spent a lot of time on consonant blends, so the class are familiar with this. We have not discussed hard and soft sounds like "giraffe" and "good", so this will be new for the class.


