Their reading fluidity and group participation are moving along well. I am happy about their continued progress. Their interest about reading short stories is quite astounding. We start by quickly introducing the story name then I read a page followed by the class. I am trying to have all of the students get into the habit of using their fingers to point at the words and go line by line to keep their focus. We do games /activities during the middle or toward the end of the class to hold their attention. Once the students have finished the story, after several times, then I will have them do a reading race game to change up things and build confidence. A solid way to boost their reading level

confidence is for the students to read to their parents at home once the those particular storybooks are brought back home.
