Reading

Reading class is one of my favorite times with the students because they are all very enthusiastic about reading and love the stories. Though the students have good reading abilities, my goal this month is to target word recognition to help them try to learn individual words instead of memorizing. This is a hard task for children in K4! I ask that the parents be patient as each child learns at a different pace and encouraging them to read at home will be helpful for their growth.

Phonics

Phonics class is one that I think a majority of students can use some more practice with. The earlier they understand how to sound out letters phonetically, the easier it will be for them to read effortlessly in the future. Luckily, our phonics textbook is colorful and I think fun for most of the children. Everyone will get a chance to practice old and new sounds while also reinforcing some essential material.

Core Material

This class is an all encompassing lesson for the students where we focus on grammar, reading, and phonics skills. The books do a great job in using stories to generate practical examples so the children may relate to the material. The children can answer questions and take turns reading.
