### Dear Parents,

The past month, our Unicorn students have been hard at work and remaining focused both with school work and graduation preparations. Forecasting for the month of April, the workload will remain on target throughout the rest of the current semester with the graduation speeches and the storybook reading contest preparations as exceptions.

In April, the reading class will have four major stories to cover. Those stories being: *Being Me, At Home in a Shell, What Can Insects Do, and Who Needs Water*. That will be a full amount of reading for the students. Once again, I need to impress upon the critical importance of both the reading classes and the stories within the core material. These classes aid in the development of each student's reading fluidity and in bolstering confidence when studying a foreign language. The song and dance class will have the Unicorn students singing "Forever Young." The phonics class will see an emphasis on more sentence completion drills plus filling in the blanks for vowels; a focus on vocabulary writing for form and neatness will remain in effect. In the *Jump* (grammar) book, the main focus will be on the days of the week with completion of activities, questions with *when* and *what time*, prepositions of place, and questions about sleep. Furthermore, we will continue with all of our other classes on schedule as best as possible. The intent is that as time gets closer to the end of the semester more mandatory activities will take priority: the storybook reading competition and graduation preparations. It is my hope that our Unicorn students will become more independent with their own thoughts and ideas in order to become good students over their whole lives. # Reading Class

The students' maturation of their reading ability and comprehension has come a long way. Unicorn students are able to understand the overall meaning of each given page. It might take the first two

days but they do read well and understand by the middle of the week. The rest of the week just solidifies the story as a whole. It is with great happiness to see each student make real progress each week and throughout the entire year. For April, the weekly reading structure will be as follows:.

#### **Phonics Class**

Unicorn students do enjoy the phonics classes. They look forward to writing another page within the phonics book. For April, we will continue to do varying exercises to reinforce previous and current concepts coupled with other phonics drills to solidify these ideas. Also beginning and final consonant blends will still be encountered at times along with fun story cut outs. Everything that is asked for on the schedule will be completed to the best of our abilities. Listed below is the curriculum for April.
