## Phonics

Phonics class this month has gone really well. I have to say, I am really happy that the kids grasp the understanding of long-A vowels so well. I was very surprised at how quick they understood the difference between the short and long vowel sounds. I tried to repeat words and sentences everyday so it stuck, and I think it really did! Next that comes will be long-O vowel sounds. I think learning these new materials slowly will be better if we want Monkey class to retain these pronunciations well. And we have time to make sure we do it correctly. I am pleasantly surprised about their progress, so many of the kids are really so bright!

## Core Material

I say this because they contain many simple words, sentences, and phonetic sounds that recap a majority of what we are learning in each subject throughout the day.

## Conversation

Monkey class does really well with the "Jump" textbook. Again, because this textbook outlines proper ways to form sentences, especially in speech, this gives them a chance to not only improve their sentence writing practice, but also how to converse in English in a way that flows correctly. I know because in Mandarin, many sentences are spoken in an opposite order compared to English so this gives us a chance to practice speaking. The majority of the class have really no issues with this so I am very happy!
