Reading

In our class, we put a lot of emphasis on our reading skills. We believe it's an important skill to develop early in order to develop other fundamental skills. This month we are starting our reading with "My Mom." This book is simple and relatable, which is great for our class to get started and be interested in reading. At this young age, the more interested kids get into the book, the more likely it is for them to improve while they enjoy it.

Core Material

In this part of the class, we start with a topic, which we expand with new vocabulary and knowledge that kids enjoy. The topic we are learning about is called "Getting to Know Us" This unit talks about ourselves, like what we do at places like school.

Grammar

Our grammar section of the class is crucial to build proper sentences and vocabulary from an early stage. It, not only, teaches them to think and speak in a correct manner; but it also covers writing properly and with proper rules. This month, we are learning about capitalization at the beginning of a sentence, punctuation, and noun quantifiers (a/an+s/es).

Conversation

In the conversation part of the class, we encourage kids to express themselves with the help of some basic sentences that are taught to the class. We mix this part of the class with either a drawing we do in class or a topic related to the reading part of the week. Conversations are a great way to help our kids speak more fluently while building their confidence. For this month of August, we will talk about our family and what they do and look like. Later on, we will cover topics, like, school activities, home activities, and outdoor activities.

Phonics

We are currently working on writing and pronouncing letters. This month we will focus on writing neatly and working on our hand-eye coordination. Hand-eye coordination is an underestimated aspect of a child's growth and development, and it is something that will show results down the road. During this month, we are specifically focusing on the letters: f, m, s, t, h, b, l, d, c, n, g, and w. We will cover and review an average of three sounds and letters a week.

Handwriting

Our handwriting part of the class is quite new to kids, but we are working on the repetition aspect of it to improve it. We will be tracing the alphabet, both upper and lower case, in order to build muscle memory when writing these letters. This month we are not quite focusing on the letters themselves, but rather the hand movement needed to write these letters. For example, for the letter 'f', we are working on the line going straight down, the horizontal line and the curved line at the top.

Physical Education

Due to the pandemic, we have been working online and have just now resumed normal classes. Due to this situation, we will use this time to review or catch up on different courses for this month. We will resume thematic activities next month.

Handwriting

Our handwriting part of the class is quite new to kids, but we are working on the repetition aspect of it to improve it. We will continue to use tracing and repetition techniques, in order to build muscle memory when writing these letters. This month we will start focusing on the actual letters and the shapes they take, while keeping in mind their position on the page. For example, for the letter 'f', we are working on the line going straight down, the horizontal line and the curved line at the top. In addition, we will focus on letters that go all the way up to the top line, and the ones that go below the bottom line.

Physical Education

Physical education provides kids with the opportunity to discharge their excess energy, improve motor skills and build social skills. Kids enjoy this time as it clears the mind from the classroom activities we do the rest of the day, as well as allowing them to focus better on other activities we do in the classroom later on. This month, we are resuming our original activities as much as restrictions allow.

Thematic Activity

Each month a different foreign teacher is assigned to plan and arrange activities of a chosen theme. This can be different things, from small art projects, short field trips near the school, or a demonstration in the classroom!
