# Reading

In our class, we put a lot of emphasis on our reading skills. We believe it's an important skill to develop early in order to develop other fundamental skills. This month we are starting with more challenging books, such as "Out the Door," which is not only challenging but also lengthy. I'm not worried about the fact that they seem challenging, since it's a bit repetitive, too. At this young age, finishing a challenging book gives kids a sense of satisfaction and encouragement.

#### **Core Material**

In this part of the class, we start with a topic, which we expand with new vocabulary and knowledge that kids enjoy. We start by finding out what they already know about the topic, followed by learning new vocabulary, and conclude with a reading activity that does a great job at teaching kids more about the topic. This month we are finishing Unit 9 and Starting Unit 10. Unit 9 is about Nature, and how we interact with it. While on unit 10 we cover topics of problem solving.

#### Math

I'm encouraged to teach math with our material, MPM books and boxes. These are great tools for kids to explore math as an interactive subject. This month, we are learning counting through interactive activities, puzzles and coloring activities from the MPM book and box.

This month, we are learning about plural nouns ending in -s or -es, using the verb "to be" with the proper pronoun I'm extremely optimistic about the results this will give.

#### **Phonics**

We are currently working on writing and pronouncing letters. This month we will focus on writing neatly and working on our hand-eye coordination. Hand-eye coordination is an underestimated aspect of a child's growth and development, and it is something that will show results down the road. During this month, we are specifically focusing on the

sounds the following letters make: ff, ss, tt, dd, gg, zz, l, d, g, m, b, n, v, t. We will then focus on high frequency words. We will cover and review an average of three sounds and letters a week.

We will also learn about letters with slants, our focus will be on the letters: o, c, d, e, a, v, y
