Reading

Maths

Our math class continues on the same subjects and activities as previously, with some slightly new concepts introduced. Most of the tasks are repeated, though changed in slight

ways to allow the students to be familiar, and able to complete on their own. The students are getting familiar with processes, counting, shadows, numbers, adding, and shapes.

Conversation (Grammar)

For June we continue practicing our conversation with the conversation book going through each page and ensuring each student is familiar with the material. We also have the students say what they can see, what they like, what they did on the weekend, and talking about their favourite things. I like to give the students a letter and have them think of as many words they can say starting with that letter, which is a great game for them to be engaged, get some points and have them thinking.

Phonics

The students all know their ABC's now, and also the phonic sounds for all the letters. We have begun sounding out words such as 'cat' with 'c' 'a' 't' and then changing the first letter to create a new word. Some of the students are grasping this concept faster than others, but a big majority of the class has already grasped this idea and are improving very nicely.

Gross/Fine Motor Skills

We have almost finished our writing book, with the students showing fantastic results at such an early age. We continue to monitor and focus on holding the pencil, with little writing now as we focus more on reading and phonics. In this time we still have the students complete worksheets using their pencil, with less writing and more line tracing for the fine motor skill ability.

Thematic Activity

The theme for thematic in June will be international culture, with a new country, theme, and story for the students to complete and learn each week.

Song and Dance

We continue to do Song and Dance as the first class of each day, beginning the day with high energy and lots of movement and fun. The students have a vast array of songs to learn through the curriculum as well as appropriate songs to be chosen by teacher (Disney, children songs, etc)

多元數學

會話(文法)

六月我們持續練習我們的會話,我們以會話書籍中透過每一頁,確定每位學生熟悉教材。我們也已經讓學生,運用他們視覺,說出他們所見的事物、他們的喜愛,他們週末做什麼事情, 及聊到他們喜歡的事物。我喜歡給學生一個字母,促使他們思考出更多的單字,從他們開始 說出有關指定的字母字彙,這是很棒的遊戲,啟發學生們的參與,同時獲得白板上的分數, 及思考力。

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發音課

學生們知道字母的 ABC,且也知道每個字的發音。我們已經開始試單字的發音,像是以貓為例,cat' with 'c' 'a' 't',以及透過替換第一個字母,創造出新的字彙。有些學生比其他的學生能更快速掌握內容,但班級主體上已能掌握,且逐漸增進改善,很好呢!

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粗大動作/精細動作(肢體發展活動)

我們已經完成大部分的寫字本,在幼齡的階段,學生們展現不錯的學習成果。我們持續進行大肌肉活動,以及焦點放在拿鉛筆。透過少量的書寫,此時段我們依舊讓學生以鉛筆完成學習單(描線、畫形狀),為了好的掌握大肌肉(手部)拿筆技巧,隨著減少寫字的時間,且增加線條的描寫。

歌舞時間

我們維持歌舞時間為每天的第一堂課,開展新的一天,以滿滿的活力、許多肢體舞動,且是趣味的。學生們學到大量的歌曲,透過課程中被老師挑選中喜愛的歌曲(像是迪士尼、兒童歌曲等等)
