

# Whale Class Newsletter July 2023

It's the final month of the semester and we only have 3 weeks of classes as the final week of the month is the summer holiday. (Excluding July 24th.) There are no special events for this month but maybe we can have a small party in the classroom at the end of the month. The class did a great job this semester, I am happy with the progress they have made in all areas, particularly writing.

#### **Core Material**

This week we are reading Reading Anthology chapter 5. This isn't a very difficult chapter so I have tried to add as much Q&A as possible and let the class get more speaking practice. There are no key words because we are doing the big book, but we will review the words the class have already learned. The book relates to body parts and how we do different things – jumping, swimming, etc.

# Writing

The class have now have a writing book and they will be completing one chapter a week. This book is relatively simple and is connected to the Reading Wonders books used in core material class. The chapters consist of a 2 page story and 3 questions which need

one word or one sentence answers. There is then a second page which asks the class to write their own sentences. I try to encourage them to write long sentences and look for extra details in the pictures.

# **Story Books**

There are only 3 books this month due to the public holidays. If you have time, try to read with them as it will encourage them to read by themselves. In class I focus on pronunciation of the sentences and also on common words – for example a story may have a lot of long vowels or focus on a few consonant blends like sh and st.. I also try to have the kids touch each words as we read so that can learn to recognize some of the words.

We also do some simple Q&A with the stories, the class are quite enthusiastic about trying to answer questions and they are have lots to say about the stories. This semester's books are a bit more complicated, but still quite similar to last semester. There is a wider variety of vocabulary and the sentence patterns are more varied, so it can be harder for the kids to remember all of the sentences.

#### Math

This month we are completing book 5. We are looking at x,y coordinates, which is quite difficult for kindergarden kids, although the class did a good job last on this topic last month. We will then move on functions, which is matching up numbers to colors or shapes on a diagram. Finally we will look at pathways, which is the easiest topic this month. The kids will look at a map and decide which color path is needed to get to a particular place.

# Handwriting Practice and Spelling書寫練習和拼音

班級現在有了一本寫作書,他們將每週完成一章。本書比較簡單,與核心教材課用到的 Reading Wonders書籍相關連。這些章節包括一個 2 頁的故事和 3 個需要一個單詞或一 句話回答的問題。 然後是第二頁,要求全班寫下自己的句子。 我試著鼓勵他們寫長句子, 並在圖片中尋找額外的細節。

除了寫作書,班級還有一套拼寫單詞。 他們在寫作方面做得很好,我試著把重點放在教發音上,而不僅僅是讓孩子們記住不同單詞的拼寫而以,也能從中練習發音拼寫。

# Story Books 故事小書

這個月只有 3 本書。 如果你有時間,試著和他們一起閱讀,因為這會鼓勵他們自己閱讀。 在課堂上,我專注於句子的發音和常用詞——例如,一個故事可能有很多長元音或專注於一 些輔音混合,如 sh 和 st。我也試著讓孩子們觸摸每個單詞 我們閱讀這樣可以學會識別一 些單詞。

我們還對故事進行了一些簡單的問答,班級非常熱衷於嘗試回答問題,他們對故事有很多話要說。 這學期的書有點複雜,但還是和上學期差不多。 詞彙種類更多,句式也更多樣,因此孩子們更難記住所有句子。

#### Math數學

這個月我們即將完成第 5 冊。我們正在研究 x,y 坐標,這對於幼兒園的孩子來說相當困難,儘管上個月班級在這個主題上做得很好。 然後我們將繼續討論函數,即將數字與圖表上的顏色或形狀進行匹配。 最後我們將討論路徑,這是本月最簡單的主題。 孩子們將查看地圖並決定到達特定地點需要哪種顏色的路徑。
