Hello Dinosaur Class Parents,

With K3 over and at the beginning of K4, we are about to see a lot of changes, as the syllabus gets ramped up with extra academic material to expose kids to all aspects of communicating in English. As well, we will start to see some big steps in progress, as students begin to write letters more neatly and can start spelling words and reading more accurately with a much bigger knowledge of sight words and vocabulary and also starting to talk more in English. The focus remains on allowing the kids to enjoy their language learning experience and not to forcefully cram them full of knowledge. So we will try our best to have fun and play in relevant ways that work in tandem with the material from all the books and classroom exercises. A very large role in students' progress here, and this can't be emphasized enough, is how much parents dedicate extra practice at home, even if it's just reading and revising the older little readers, everyday, for the shortest 5 to 10 min at the very least, then this will make the world of a difference.

### **Reading**

As I have already shared in the weekly communications about the readers, there is quite a big leap in difficulty compared to the K3 book selection. But this is not to raise concern, only to be aware that while it seems like there is little progress, in actual fact students are able or should be able to read their older reader with more proficiency as they currently struggle with harder books with longer sentences and bigger words. Staying ahead of students' progress leaves more room for further progress and keeps them thinking and guessing and learning. Here is the schedule for the next couple months:

## **Core Material**

The Core Material Books are the McGraw Hill Reading Wonders books, there are 2 of them that we will be working through, the workshop and Anthology. Workshop has writing elements, but we won't be using these as they are a level above what the students are capable of, but the reading and themes provide great material to discuss in class for conversation practice.

The first units emphasize on short vowels and later on work blends and other phonics rules.

## **MPM Math (Multiple Practice Module)**

The MPM books and boxes allow for a much more interactive learning experience. The kids really enjoy this subject because more often than not, it feels like playing. Which also means a lot more inclination to get distracted with all the goodies in the box, and now that they are more familiar with the process of using only what the lessons ask for, they seem to be more disciplined with what to use and when. I still always change up which colors need to be used, to test their listening and understanding skills, this also teaches them to be patient and follow instructions more carefully.

## **Grammar - Space**

This book is a new addition to the kids usual routine of books we work through. And the level is quite a fair bit more difficult too. Some exercises require more writing that is beyond their current abilities, so we will bypass them temporarily and return to complete

them when kids reach the appropriate level to complete them with more constructive efficiency. The Grammar book covers a wide range of grammar concepts including capitalisation and singular nouns starting with vowels, pluralisation and some exceptions to the rules.
