*The capital of Egypt is Cairo. The official language of Egypt is Arabic. The population of Egypt is 90,120,000 people.*



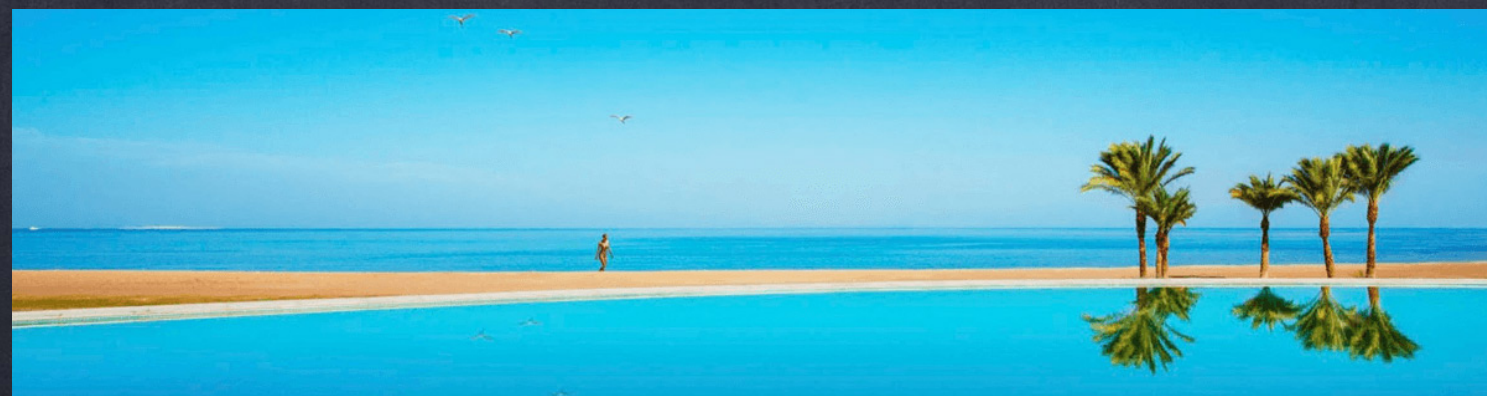
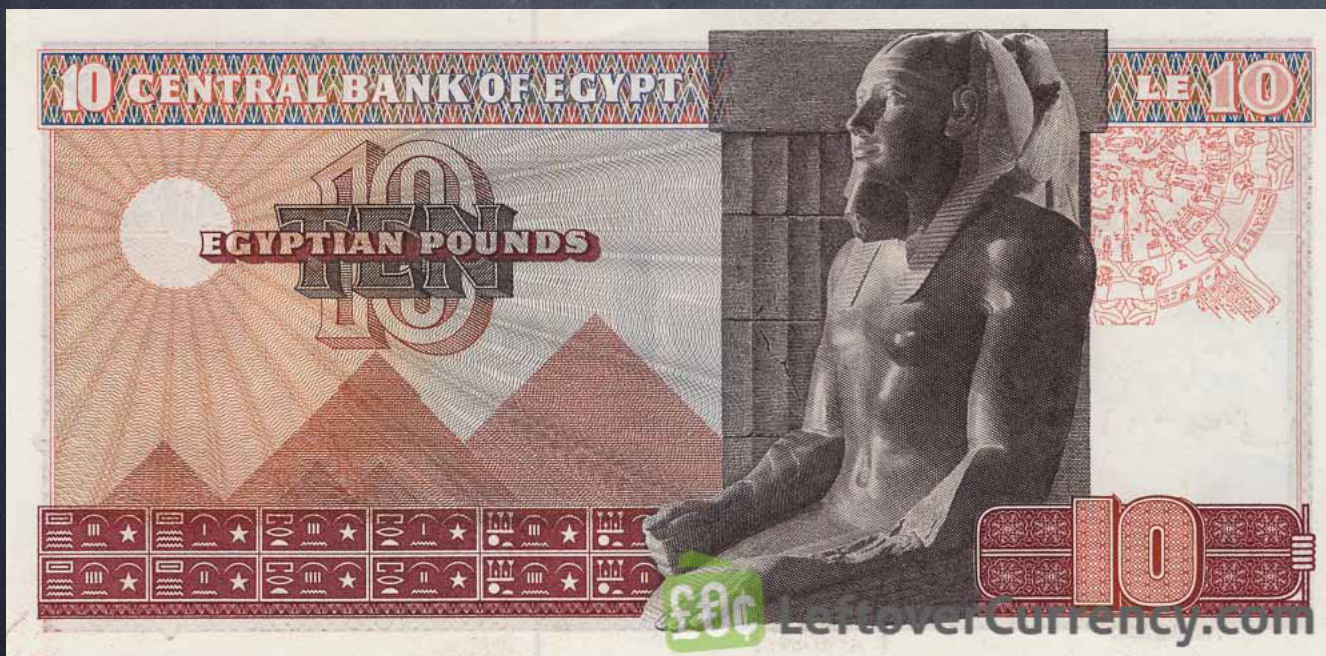


*What's it like living in Egypt?*

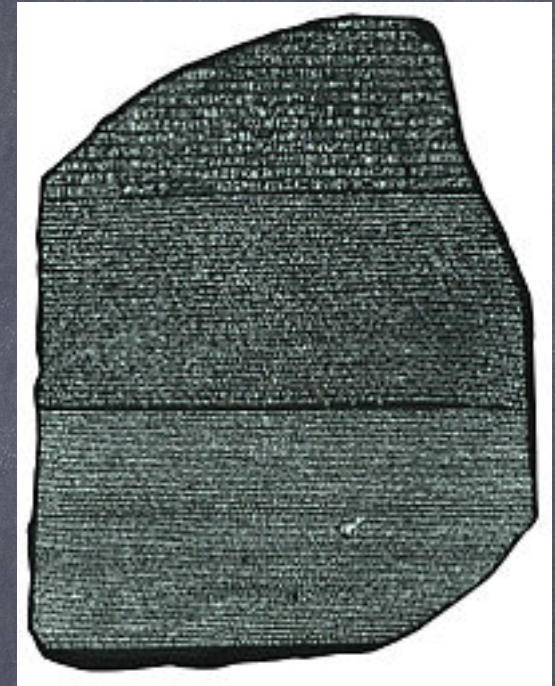




Let me tell you a little history about Egypt.

# The Nile River



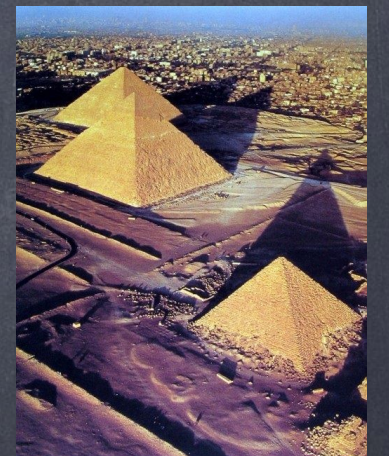
RIVER NILE MAP

If you're education is high, you have more opportunities to earn money. If you're education is low, your opportunities to earn money are fewer.





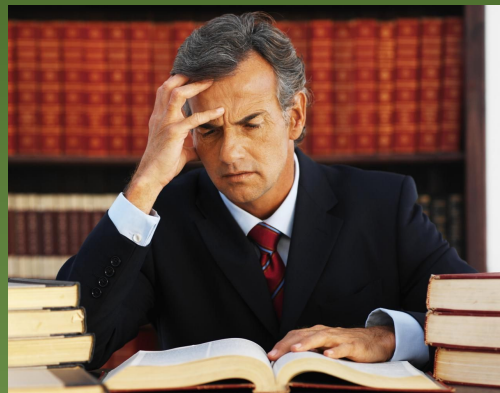
People who don't get a higher education usually end up in low paying jobs, like drivers, laborers and service workers.

# Do you want to be a doctor? What does a doctor do? How does a doctor spend their day?

Most full-time ER doctors work in shifts ranging from 6 to 12 hours long. On average, a full-time ER job may include 10 twelve-hour shifts per month.



Essentially the duties of an ER physician during that shift is to take care of the patients that roll into the ER and create a disposition for them: treatment and discharge, consultation with specialists, or admission to the hospital.

**An Astronaut is a person that has gone through rigorous training in order to command, pilot, or serve as a crew member in a spacecraft. They work for human spaceflight programs which are usually run by governments, either by military or civilian space agencies; although there are some private companies that schedule and organize commercial space flights.**
