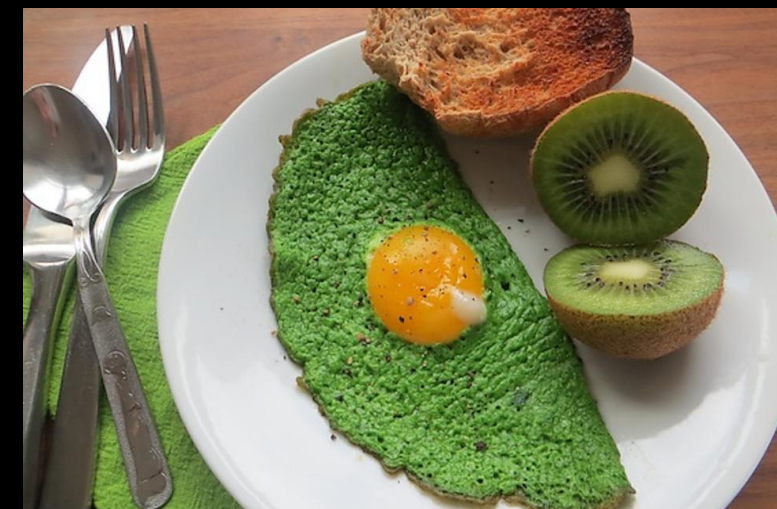
The celebration I'm talking about is called St. Patrick's Day
