After he got word that the Chu capital had fallen to the Qin army, however, he walked into a river and drowned himself because he was so sad.

The most popular activity of the Dragon Boat Festival is racing Dragon boats. Many differnt groups compete with each other, racing row boats, with a drummer setting the pace for the rowers.
