What does the Arctic look like?








The Arctic habitat is a very cold place at the top of the world where some plants and animals live, it is made up of the Arctic

Approximately 1,700 species of plants live on the Arctic tundra including: flowering plants, dwarf shrubs, herbs, grasses, mosses, and lichens.












Arctic Animals






What do I think about the Arctic?
