


SAVE THE ANIMALS

Now there are only 3890 tigers in the wild because humans are destroying their habitat, so they don't have places to hide from hunters.

What do they eat?

They eat meat and will not usually eat any sort of vegetation. In order to eat, the tiger must hunt for its prey; a process that is taught to the cubs by the mother when they are only a few months old to train them for survival on their own. When food is not available, the tiger will eat berries, grasses and different types of fruit.

Red Panda





How many red pandas are left in the wild?

Now there are only 10,000 red pandas left in the wild. Why?
Because humans keep building buildings and destroying their habitat. As a result the red panda doesn't have many places to live.
So now we need to protect them.

What do they eat?



Red pandas eat bamboo shoots and bamboo leaf tips. They also eat roots, grasses and fruits. Sometimes, they will eat eggs, insects, birds and small mammals, but they mostly eat bamboo.
