

Endangered Animals








Vaquitas are the world's most rare marine mammal. It is on the edge of extinction.

Vaquita are often caught and drowned in gillnets used by illegal fishing operations in marine protected areas within Mexico's Gulf of California.

What do vaquita eat?







Pangolin

Pangolin are the only mammals wholly-covered in scales and they use those scales to protect themselves from predators in the wild.

What do pangolin eat?

Pangolins eat ants, termites, and larvae and are often known as "the scaly anteater." Because they have no teeth, pangolins pick up food with their sticky tongues, which can sometimes reach lengths greater than the animal's body.
