Reading

At Marshall, cultivating proficient readers is a top priority. Our objective is for students to become independent readers with a robust understanding of phonics and accurate pronunciation by the conclusion of the first year. This class not only expands vocabulary but also fosters verbal aptitude, igniting creativity and motivating students to read on their own. By the end of the second semester, many are enthusiastic to read on their own.

Math

Using MPM books and boxes, our math class presents common mathematical concepts in a unique and interesting way, often incorporating animals, colors, and objects associated with fun and games. These month's focus includes:

Conversation

We use the Up and Away book for the conversation class. It focuses on daily speaking practice using simple but correct sentence structures.

Motor Skills

In this class, we teach motor skills development as a crucial aspect of kindergarten education. We focus on teaching motor skills because they form the foundation for a child's physical and cognitive growth. Fine motor skills, such as holding a pencil or using scissors, are essential for writing, drawing, and other academic tasks. Gross motor skills, like running, jumping, and balancing, contribute to overall physical health and coordination. By honing these skills, children improve their hand-eye coordination, spatial awareness, and self-confidence.

Song and Dance

This class is a bonding opportunity for students and myself, where we enjoy songs together. In addition to scheduled songs, I'll be teaching children more songs from children's films, musicals, or any songs suitable for children.

Thematic Activity

Each month, a different foreign teacher plans and arranges activities based on a given theme, fostering cultural understanding through small art projects, short field trips, or classroom parties. The August theme is "Ocean" and September theme is "Autumn"

Library/Storybook

Each week, the children and I visit the library for story time and book exchanges. Sometimes I also look for a book myself to read to the kids, enhancing listening skills and fostering imagination.

Reading

在瑪歇爾,培養熟練閱讀是我們的首要任務。我們的目標是讓學生在第一年結束時,能夠成為獨立的閱讀者,具備扎實的語音知識和準確的發音。這門課程不僅擴展詞彙量,還提升口語能力,激發創造力並激勵學生自主閱讀。到第二學期結束時,許多學生將會熱衷於自主閱讀。

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September 23rd – September 27th: We Can Go September 30th – October 4th: Can You See It

Core Material

這門課程結合了閱讀、文法和語音技能。學生通過圖片來分析故事,練習母音發音,並運用關鍵詞來構建句子和理解文法概念。我們使用一系列適合年齡的書籍,這些書籍具有吸引孩童的格式,對幼稚園小朋友的識字發展取有良好的效果。

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September 30th – October 4th: I Can! (P46-63)

Phonics

在語音課程中,我們使用 Sadlier Phonics A,這是一本內容豐富且布局簡單的書,用於練習字母發音。這一堂課讓每位學生都有機會練習舊的和新的發音,同時鞏固基本知識。

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Math

我們的數學課程使用 MPM 書籍和教具,以獨特且有趣的方式呈現常見的數學概念,常常融入動物、顏色和與娛樂相關的物品。本月的重點包括:

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Motor Skills

大小肌肉發展是這一堂課的學習關鍵。這一堂課所學習的技能是孩子身心成長的基礎。精細運動技能,如握筆或使用剪刀,對於書寫、繪畫以及其他學業任務至關重要。粗大運動技能,如跑步、跳躍和平衡,則有助於整體的身體健康和協調能力。通過磨練這些技能,孩子們能夠提高手眼協調、空間感知能力和自信心。

Song and Dance

這一堂課是學生與我透過歌曲建立關係的機會。除了預定的歌曲外,我還會教孩子更多的音樂劇或其他適合兒童的歌曲。

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Thematic Activity

每個月會由不同的外籍老師根據指定主題計劃來安排當月的勞作。通過實踐活動了解他們周圍的世界。八月的主題是「海洋」,九月的主題是「秋天」。

Library/Storybook

我和孩子們會去一次圖書館閱讀並交換圖書。有時我也會挑選一本合適的書來說故事給孩子們聽,增強他們的聆聽技巧並培養想像力。
