Welcome to the Cheetah Class monthly newsletter for August and September.

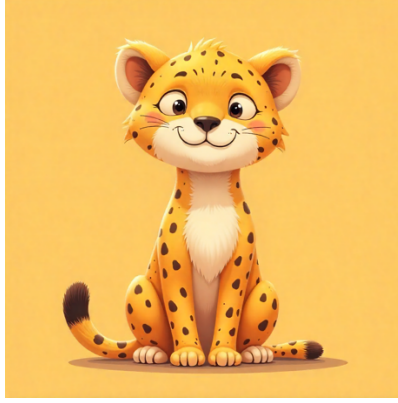
